



MEDIATION MOSAIC

AGREEMENT FOR MEDIATIONS HELD VIA VIDEO CONFERENCE

- Connect to the video conference at least 5 minutes before your mediation is scheduled to begin. If you choose to connect to the audio by telephone, do not place your telephone on hold while you are connected to the conference. You may mute your phone. Background noise should be kept to an absolute minimum.
- Once you connect to the video conference, it is the same as if you have walked into the mediation conference room and you are bound by the same rules of courtesy and attention that you would be if the mediation were held in person. If a technological problem arises, be advised that the mediator may not be able to continue without the participation of all of the parties. In the event of repeated delays for signal problems or interference, the mediator may reschedule the video conference as recurring technological problems are not conducive to the open flow of communication that is necessary for mediation.
- An online mediation shall be governed by and conducted in accordance with this Agreement and TEX. CIV. PRAC. & REM. Code §154.001, *et seq.* To protect the confidentiality of the mediation, **do not** access the video conference in any settings where third parties may be present or in spaces where other people can overhear the discussion. **All parties to the mediation are strictly prohibited from making any video or audio recordings of the session.**
